It is in this spirit of community support that we would like to give back and help others achieve their goals and aspirations. We will be awarding two scholarships for the 2025-26 academic school year. Eligible high school seniors and current college students are invited to apply by March 1, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY

GCVA will be awarding a \$2,000.00 scholarship to one eligible high school senior and a \$2,000,00 scholarship to one eligible current college student.

- Applicant must be an Alaska Resident.
- Applicant must be majoring in or planning to major in visual arts.
- Applicant must be attending or planning to attend an accredited 4-year university and pursuing a bachelor's degree as a full-time student.
- Applicant must submit at least one piece of artwork for display in our April scholarship show. Artwork will be returned at the end of the show.
- Scholarship must be used for the 2025-2026 academic school year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following needs to be submitted via email to gcvamanager@gmail.com along with the completed application:

<u>Artwork samples</u> – Images of artwork will be submitted digitally with application. A minimum of 3 samples and a maximum of 10 will be accepted. At least one submitted sample must be available and used for April Show. Mediums accepted are: painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, photography, glass art, fiber art, jewelry, mixed media and metal arts.

Artist Statement – Applicant must submit an artist statement of 3 – 10 sentences about their work.

Essay – Applicant must submit an essay of 250 – 500 words about why you want to be an artist.

Letter of Recommendation – Applicant must provide 1 letter of recommendation

College Information Required

High school students: The scholarship will be awarded contingent on college acceptance letter to be forwarded to GCVA no later than May 1. Scholarship will not be awarded without letter and will be forfeited if not provided.

College Students: Applicants must submit student financial services office contact information on application.

Scholarship winners will be announced on April 4, 2025. All applicants will be required to submit a piece of artwork from their application by March 30, 2025 for display in our April Show. Artwork may be offered for sale if applicant desires. Artwork will be available for pick up after the show on May 1, 2025 or later. GCVA retains the right not to display artwork should it be deemed inappropriate for display for any reason.
